in the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry
Zero Energy House Demonstration Project**

Keio University was chosen to design and build a so-called "Net Zero Energy" demonstration house by the Japanese Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, Agency of Natural Resources and Energy, as part of their Environmental Improvement Initiative.

The project is aimed at standardizing and main-streaming the technology associated with the net-zero energy concept..

Professor Yasushi Ikeda, of the SFC Graduate School of Media and Governance is the spokesperson and leader for the project, which is being undertaken primarily within Keio University's Environment and Culture Regeneration Research Lab. With the co-operation of the Faculty of Science and Engineering, Department of System Design, an academic/industry consortium was founded in order to include sponsorship and support of several corporations who are able to bring to bear their advanced technical knowledge and skills.

From January 29 (Wednesday) to 31 (Friday), 2014, the completed demonstration house will be exhibited in the Shinonome Parking Area at Tokyo Big Site as a part of the ENEMANE House Exhibition. There, it will have a chance to be tested by occupation, and visitors will be given the opportunity to vote for their favorite project via the "People's Choice Award"
